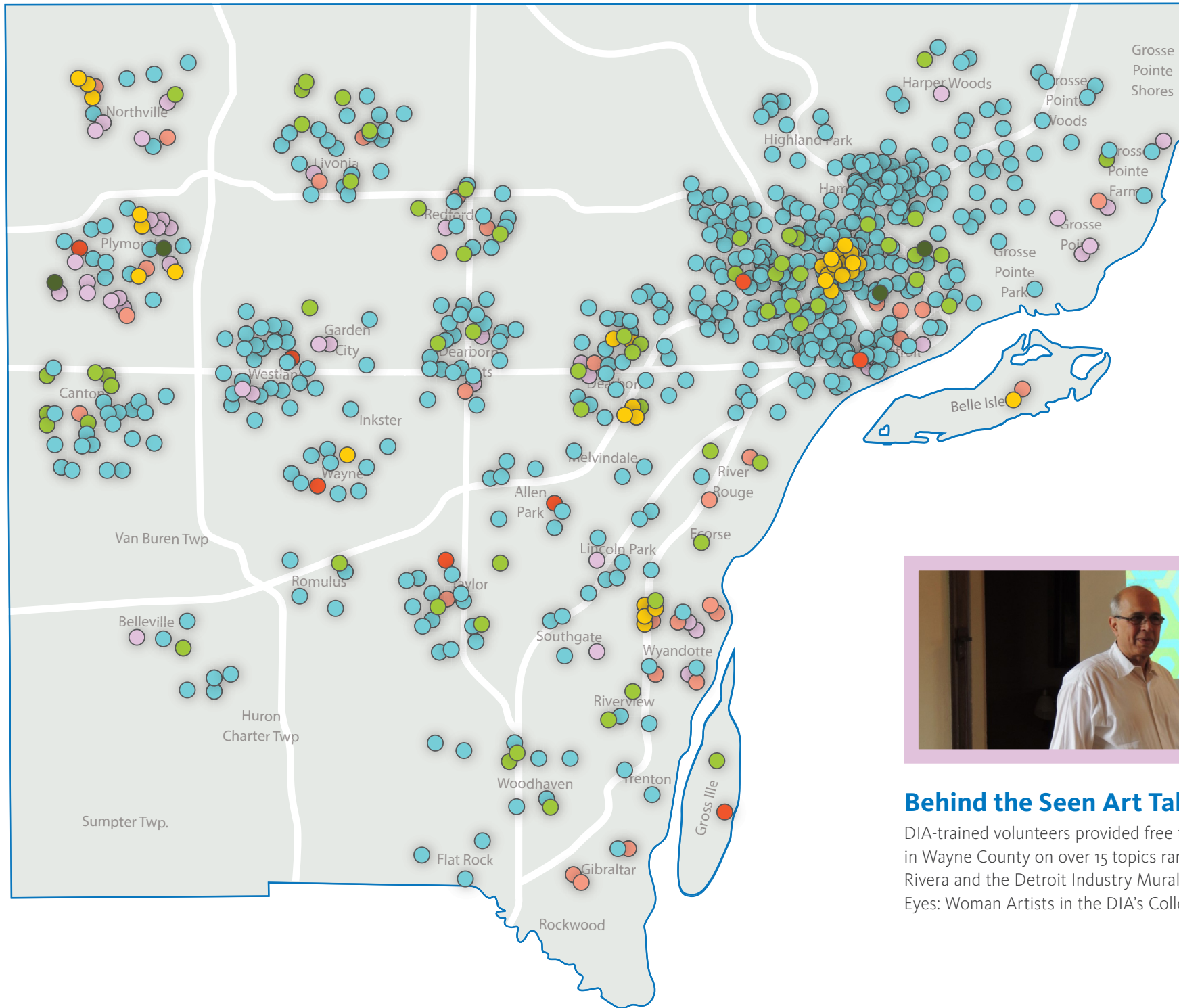

Senior groups from **61** organizations in Wayne county participated in the DIA's Thursdays at the Museum program last year, with more than **2,000** visitors aged 55 and over participating in tours, art-making, films, and more with complimentary reception and group transportation provided.

DIA studio artists held workshops at fifteen community events engaging over **5,800** people in art-making projects.



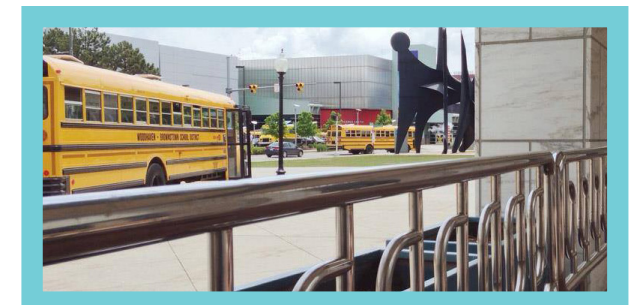
Director's Cut

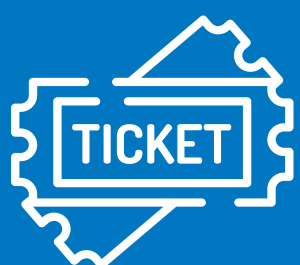
