



BAG AND PARCEL POLICY

Save time by traveling lightly!

The Detroit Institute of Arts (DIA) offers complimentary attended coat-check facilities at both public entrances. These entrances are located off of Farnsworth Street and Woodward Avenue.

The following rules and restrictions are in place for your safety and the safety of the art:

- All backpacks, tote bags, briefcases, portfolios, luggage, packages and umbrellas must be checked in at the coat-check facilities. Avoid waiting in long lines by leaving these items in your car or at home.
- Any bags larger than 11" x 15" x 6" must be checked at the coat-check facilities.
- Musical instruments cannot be brought into the Museum without prior written authorization and may not be checked at the coat-check facilities.
- Strollers are allowed in the galleries. Oversized and jogging strollers are not permitted. Complimentary "umbrella" strollers are available at coat-check facilities on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- Camera tripods or extension devices (commonly known as "selfie sticks") and other objects with sharp or pointed tips are not permitted in the Museum without prior written authorization.

Medical bags and diaper bags are excluded from this policy but must be kept close to your body at all times.

The following items cannot be checked at coat-check facilities:

- Purses or handbags
- Wallets
- Perishables
- Bikes
- Computers
- Oversized and jogging strollers (unless guests are using a complimentary umbrella stroller during their visit)
- Other items deemed to be of high value

Purses that exceed the size restrictions (11" x 15" x 6") or any style of purse worn on the back are not permitted in the Museum and should be secured in your vehicle's trunk or out of sight in the passenger compartment.

School groups are encouraged to leave backpacks on their buses whenever possible to avoid delays when arriving. School groups who have a need to bring backpacks into the Museum will be provided with coat rack and bag storage while they explore our galleries (identified by your school name).

The DIA reserves the right to refuse any items and is not responsible for items held in the coat-check facilities. All articles must be claimed before the Museum closes. Unclaimed items will be turned over to Museum Security as lost and found and handled accordingly.

The DIA reserves the right to inspect any bag, person, or parcel on the property at any time.
