### Photography Policy for Visitors

Visitors may photograph or take videos of the permanent collection for personal or noncommercial use under the following conditions:

- Flash photography, camera bags, tripods, monopods, selfie-sticks, extension cords, additional lights or other photography equipment are not allowed.
- The camera must be at least three (3) feet or a reasonable arm's length from the work of art.
- Photography cannot disrupt the normal operations of the museum or the experience of other visitors. Photography or activity that endangers the collection is not permitted.
- Art is protected under the United States Copyright law; sale of your photograph(s) is not permitted.
- Photographs may not be taken of artwork with a "No Camera" symbol  on the label.
- Photography is not allowed in the following areas:
  - Special Exhibition galleries (unless otherwise specified in writing)
  - Schwartz Galleries of Prints & Drawings
  - Albert and Peggy de Salle Gallery of Photography
  - Galleries with a "No Photography" sign or a "No Camera" symbol
