Wedding Photography Policy

For Brides and Grooms / Wedding Parties having their Ceremony / Reception at the DIA ON THE DAY OF YOUR EVENT:

We are pleased to allow wedding photography inside and outside the museum. **On the day of the event only**, photographs may be taken in all **DIA approved** spaces. A list of spaces will be provided by the DIA Catering Manager. Only professional photography is allowed. When taking photos in spaces inside the museum, other than Rivera Court and Great Hall, the bridal party must have a DIA escort at all times and remain together as a group.

During public hours, the photographer must ensure that photography does not interfere with the museum-goers experience. Museum visitors should not experience any restrictions due to photo set-up or equipment. The photography session must not block visitor access to works of art.

For Brides and Grooms / Wedding Parties NOT having their Ceremony / Reception at the DIA:

Because we need to maintain the optimal museum-going experience for visitors, no wedding-related photography is allowed inside the DIA. Wedding photography is allowed in pre-approved locations on the museum grounds.

Approved outdoor photography locations: The Detroit Film Theatre marble staircase, Woodward Ave. museum stairs and lower plaza fountains (seasonal), by the Alexander Calder sculpture (John R. St. side of the building) and on all lawns.
