



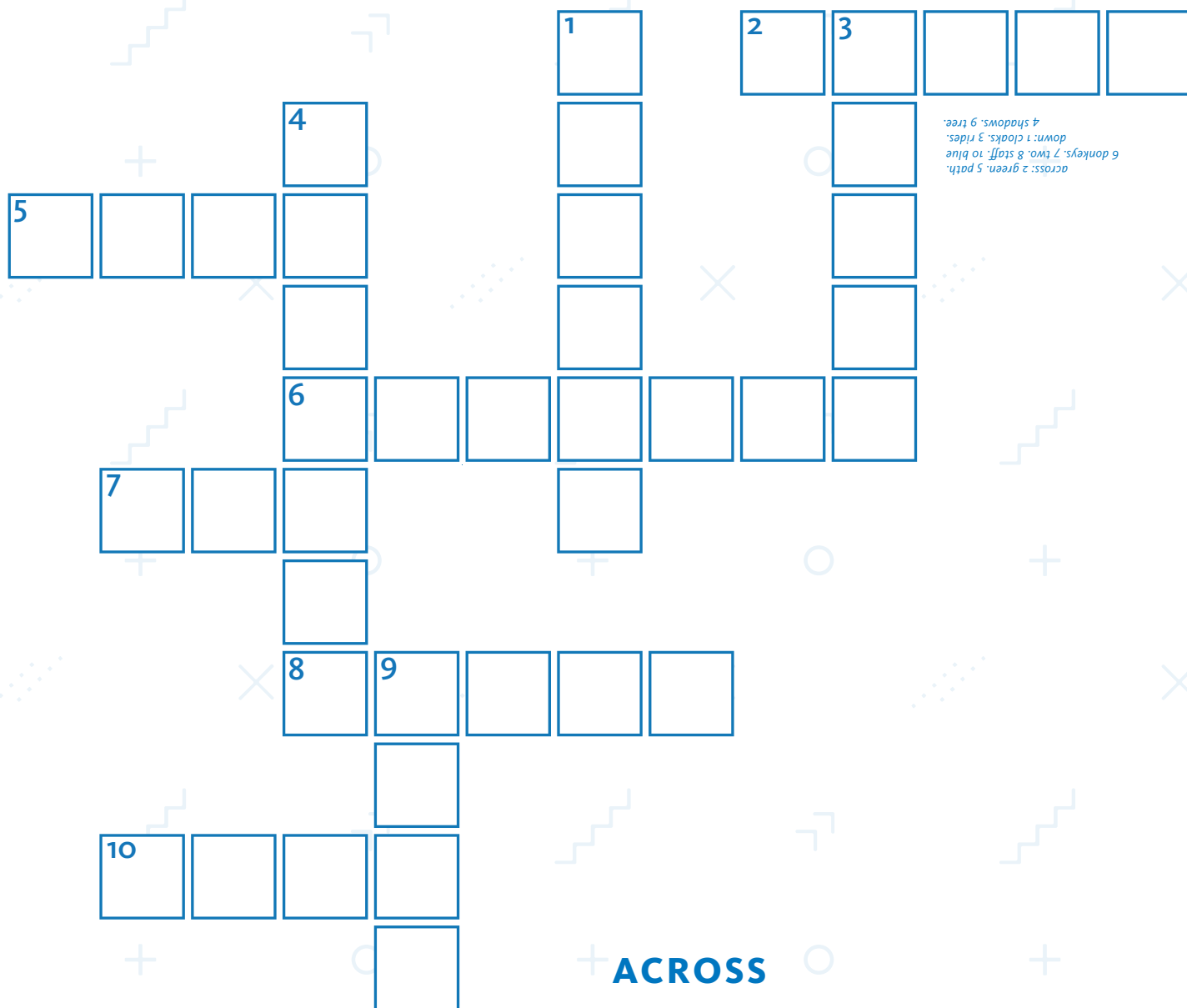
# DIA COLLECTION CROSSWORD
